The Arctic Paper colour palette consists of blue and red hues. When using the primary colours Arctic Paper blue and Arctic Paper red in combination make sure to do that in subtle way. More classy appearances are possible using the primary colours in combination with secondary colours. When using colour in a more extensive way make sure to use the lighter colours instead of the primary colours and the darker secondary colours.

Note: Be careful with the use of red for financial data and infographics.
